 - Dean Wilson is going to talk to the school district to see if it would be a possibility to have the school district email the survey to their mailing list.
 - It was discussed if an outside company should be hired to conduct the survey or should it be done through an online service such as Survey Monkey.
 - Survey should be completed by mid-July.
