**NEW BUSINESS**

- Concessions
  - Jeff Simons will be meeting with Pepsi at the end of January to discuss concession options. Pepsi has offered to sell us the product at the same price that we would purchase it from the store which would save on travel expenses.
  - It was recommended that perishable foods not be included in concessions items sold. Concession items should be limited to candy, chips and frozen pizzas.
  - Dean Wilson will provide information for a program that provides the price margin for items sold.
  - Selling concessions at baseball/softball games was discussed. Prices for concession carts are being investigated.
  - It was suggested that it be offered to area groups/organizations to sell concessions at local events for a percentage of the profits.
- Programming
  - Robert Slauson will offer a triathlon training/introduction program. The program will be a five week program for children ages 7-14 years.
- Hours of Operation
  - Weekend pool hours will be changed to 11:00 a.m.-6:00 p.m.
- New ADA Laws for 2012-possible ramifications
  - It has been brought to the attention of Jeff Simons that the pool is possibly not ADA compliant because of the lack of a lift in and out of the pool for disabled individuals. The lack of a lift could lead to a fine or legal ramifications.
