AD-HOC SWIMMING POOL COMMITTEE
FEBRUARY 8, 2012

Rob Slauson called the meeting of the Ad-Hoc Swimming Pool Committee to order at 6:00 p.m.

ROLL CALL

NEW BUSINESS

- Mary Van Dyke Resignation
 - A resignation email was received by members of the Ad-Hoc Swimming Pool Committee from Mary Van Dyke.
- Concessions
 - Pepsi is able to provide concessions with comparable rates to us purchasing it ourselves that would include delivery.
 - Pepsi would also be willing to supply us with a large cooler for drinks and a slushy machine at no additional cost.
 - Jeff Simons recommends that perishable concessions be avoided to minimize waste.
 - Rob Slauson suggests that ice cream bars get offered as a concession if a freezer can be provided by Pepsi or donated.
- Programming
 - Program descriptions need to be submitted by the following week if they will be included in the Spring/Summer Activity Guide.
 - Life jackets and suits will be allowed in the pool area this summer if they are Coast Guard approved.
 - Water wings, inner tubes, etc. will not be allowed.
 - Birthday parties will be offered at a group rate during normal pool hours that will include pizza and drinks.
- Hours of Operation
 - Saturday and Sunday hours will be extended to open at 11:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m.
 - Depending on how the extended hours work during the 2012 summer season it will be budgeted to expand the pool hours further during the 2013 summer season.

- New ADA Laws for 2012
 - Jeff Simons is still researching the laws.
 - The chair lift is approximately \$7,000.
- Direction of the Committee
 - The question is being asked if there is support from the community to build a new pool.
 - A wish list needs to be put together prior to the next meeting by board members. The wish list should consist of three plans ranging in priorities from top to bottom.
 - Fundraising ideas are being discussed.
- Community Survey
 - Surveys will be sent to area residents as a way to gauge support for the communities desire to build a new pool.
 - Options are being discussed as to which way would be the most effective to distribute the surveys, as well as who should be included in the survey.
- Review of what the committee has done-report sent to City Council
 - Jeff Simons is recommending that a report be put together and submitted to the City Council to ensure that they are aware of what the Swimming Pool Ad-Hoc Committee is working on.
