CONSIDER SEX OFFENDER RESIDENCY APPEAL FROM RALPH T. WOLF

Neighbors, Tim Combs, Karen Combs, Dave Ketchpaw, Kimberly Gillet, Lawna McKinnell, Randy Murray, and Mary Cummings to Ralph T. Wolf spoke against allowing Ralph T. Wolf to reside at 519A N. Lincoln St. Gloria Wolf, Ralph Wolf's mother, said he keeps all his doctor and psychiatrist appointments, and attended all the classes and spent 13 years in prison. City Attorney Phillips said the ordinance prohibits Wolf from moving within the City and he does not meet the exceptions. Police Chief Christensen said the neighbors and landlord were notified about the appeal. Ralph Wolf said he is with his mother 24/7, 7 days a week and they have been together since 2002 without any incidents. **Motion (McClory/Rehberg) to deny the sex offender residency appeal of Ralph T.
