Alderman Julie Taylor called the Finance and Judicial Committee to order at 5:45 p.m. followed by roll call.

**REVIEW OF N. CHURCH STREET BID**

Motion (Taylor/McClory) to recommend to Council approval of the Mann Bros. bid for the reconstruction of N. Church Street for \$2,479,699.24. Motion carried by the majority present.

In discussion, City Engineer Welsh presented to Committee a life cycle costing summary which was compiled using a program developed by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation. Based on this analysis, the life cycle cost for concrete reflects a 10% greater cost than asphalt. Welsh said a favorable price came in on asphalt as an alternate bid resulting in \$120,000 less than concrete. Alderman Taylor asked if money would have to be set aside in the budget to future overlays. Welsh said yes. Welsh said he likes the concrete streets, but recommends the asphalt due to scheduling for Holton Horn Factory and Holton Manor.

Committee recommended future discussion on a policy concerning what types of roads should be asphalt or concrete.

Motion (McClory/Taylor) to adjourn at 6:00 p.m. Motion carried by the majority present.
