Chairman Julie Taylor called the Human Resources Committee meeting at 5:00 p.m. followed by Roll Call.

PROPOSAL RE: POOL MANAGER'S POSITION

Motion (McClory/Dunwiddie) to recommend to Council approval of a proposal by the Parks and Recreation Director Jeff Simons to create a Pool Manager's position that encompasses the summer and winter pool seasons at a salary of \$13,500. Motion carried by the majority present.

The salary is within the amount budgeted for 2007. In addition, Simons told the Committee that at present the head lifeguards are making more than the Pool Manager, a position that has not been raised in 5 years. The revised position will rectify the difference.

Alderman Taylor asked about the future of the pool and the position. City Administrator Tapson said that in some format the City will be running swimming lessons. The position is expected to be kept for several years. Simons said that approximately 200 to 300 children use the pool every day and about 250 sign up for lessons.
