AMEND TRANSIENT MERCHANTS ORDINANCE

Committee discussed the present Transient Merchants Ordinance. The City Clerk informed the Committee that there were some areas that needed revising due to some recent issues with applicants. The Clerk presented a revised application. The application contained the addition of the following: a Wisconsin Sellers Permit requirement; dates, time period and places where sale of goods will take place; contact of applicant changed from 7 days after leaving the City to six months; the insertion of naming the City of Elkhorn as additionally insured; application submitted 10 days prior to the issuance of the license; and a fee of \$50 rather than \$25. The Clerk will revise the ordinance and bring it back to Committee for review.

SPECIAL EVENT UPDATE

Staff presented a brief update on the events that have taken place. Police Chief Christensen presented a list of events that Police Officers were present and their cost for working the event.
