DISCHARGE OF DANGEROUS WEAPONS

Attorney Phillips presented information based on his review of the laws related to open carry of dangerous weapons. He stated that the law allows the municipality to regulate but may not be more restrictive than the State statutes. Draft language was presented and discussed. Motion (Dunwiddie/Reynolds) to recommend approval to Council. Motion carried.

PARKING FOR SPECIAL EVENTS

Draft language to allow for parking in front yards during the Walworth County Fair in the area of the fairgrounds was presented by Clerk Igl. Motion (Dunwiddie/Reynolds) to recommend approval to Council with minor changes discussed. Motion carried.

MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 5 FIRE PROTECTION REVISION

Fire Chief Smith stated that he had reviewed the draft of the revised code section Chapter 5 Fire Protection. It was requested that the draft language be submitted to Attorney Phillips for review. If there are no suggested changes, it was requested that the language be sent to Council. Motion (Reynolds/Dunwiddie) to recommend approval of the language to Council. Motion carried.
