Chairman Julie Taylor called the Legislative and Regulatory Committee meeting at 5:30 p.m. followed by Roll Call.

**ROLL CALL**

**TRANSFER APPLICATION CLASS "B" BEER/"CLASS B" LIQUOR LICENSE**

Chief Christensen stated that a transfer application for a Class "B" Beer/"Class B" liquor license was received from Viviana Incorporated, dba Calabria as the business has moved from the previous location of 31 N. Wisconsin Street to 1 N. Lincoln Street. The Police Department had completed an inspection. Motion (Dunwiddie/Anderson) to recommend approval of the transfer contingent on the application being modified to list the physical description as the interior of the premises at 1 N. Lincoln Street. Motion carried.

**CLASS "B" BEER/CLASS C WINE LICENSE APPLICATION**

Lakeland Players Ltd. had filed an application for a Class "B" Beer/Class C Wine license. Chief Christensen stated that Lakeland Players are not eligible for a Class C wine license. He had been in contact with one of the officers to inform the group of that and it was stated that Lakeland Players wished to proceed with the Class "B" Beer license application. The Police Department scheduled an inspection for Saturday, 10/1. Motion (Anderson/Dunwiddie) to recommend approval of the Class "B" Beer license for Lakeland Players subject to a current sellers permit number being provided and the successful completion of inspections. Motion carried.

**SECTION 12 EVENTS LANGUAGE**

A draft of revised language was reviewed. Motion (Taylor/Dunwiddie) to submit the ordinance to Council for a first reading. Motion carried.

**SECTION 12 TRANSIENT MERCHANT**

A draft of revised language was reviewed and suggestions for a few minor changes were provided. A revision will be presented to the Committee at the October meeting.

**MUNICIPAL CODE AMENDMENTS**

***Plan Commission Membership***

A memo had been submitted by Administrator Tapson stating that Mayor Reynolds has requested consideration of an amendment to the Code that would extend eligibility for Plan Commission membership to include residents in the City's ETP. It was discussed that the City could advertise a vacancy on the Plan Commission and interested parties could be asked to submit a letter of interest. More clarification on this issue was requested.

***Concealed Weapons Ban***

Information on Wisconsin's Concealed Carry law was provided by Chief Christensen. After discussion, it was requested that this item be placed on the Common Council agenda for discussion and that materials provided to the Committee be included in the Council packet.
