SECTION 12 TRANSIENT MERCHANTS DRAFT LANGUAGE

After review, motion (Dunwiddie/Anderson) to recommend approval of the revised language to Council. Motion carried.

MUNICIPAL CODE AMENDMENTS

The Committee discussed the request from Mayor Reynolds that Plan Commission membership eligibility be extended to include the City's ETP. It was the consensus that membership be limited to residents of the City.

An example of ordinances regulating dumpsters and PODS from the Village of Whitefish Bay were reviewed and discussed. The ordinances reviewed only regulate dumpsters and PODS that are on the public right of way. It was questioned whether the City can regulate them on private property. It was requested that staff follow up on this question.

Committee members were asked to review Section 17.6-3 Parking regulations and Section 7.11 Stopping or parking prohibited in certain specific places regarding parking in front yards. This issue will be placed on the next committee agenda for further discussion.
