Alderman Jim D'Alessandro called the Legislative and Regulatory Committee meeting at 4:00 p.m. followed by Roll Call.

ROLL CALL

SEASONAL LEAF BURNING

Fire Chief Smith stated that a change is proposed to Section 5.17(5)(b) which will set the minimum distance for open burning at 25' from any occupied building. Motion (Rehberg/Payson) to recommend to Council the adoption of Ordinance No. 13-10. Motion carried.

CONSIDER DEMERIT POINT ASSESSMENT

Chief Christensen provided notification to the Committee that the department had recently performed a Controlled Underage Buyer program at licensed establishments. Three establishments served the underage buyers. The individuals that served were cited for the violations and convicted. It was recommended that 75 demerit points be assessed against the respective licenses. Captain Anzalone stated that he had discussed the violations with the license holders and found them to be very cooperative and concerned with the violations. After discussion, motion (Payson/Rehberg) to assess 40 demerit points against Wilson Meats, Inc. Motion carried. Motion (Payson/Rehberg) to assess 40 demerit points against the Elk Restaurant. Motion carried.

Tim Shiroda, Elkhorn Wine & Spirits, stated that he has a difficult situation with an employee that he will be addressing. Captain Anzalone stated that he had provided additional training regarding checking id's to Mr. Shiroda's staff. After discussion, motion (Payson/Rehberg) to assess 40 demerit points against Elkhorn Wine & Spirits. Motion carried.
