Alderman Jim D'Alessandro called the Legislative and Regulatory Committee meeting at 4:00 p.m. followed by Roll Call.

**ELKHORN POLICE DEPARTMENT COMPLAINT: THE REDDROOM**

Captain Anzalone stated that the Police Department had filed a complaint regarding activities that had taken place at The Reddroom. It was agreed by the Committee that the process to determine demerit points should move forward. A hearing date of July 8 at 6:00 p.m. was set. Motion (Payson/D'Alessandro) to issue summons. Motion carried.

**CHAPTER 13: MUNICIPAL UTILITIES**

Draft language for amendments to Chapter 13 was presented to the Committee. Administrator Tapson stated that these amendments should be placed on hold until the utility merger is complete. Motion (Payson/Rehberg) to table. Motion carried.

**SEX OFFENDER RESIDENCY RESTRICTIONS**

It was clarified for the Committee that the penalty for violation of the proposed sex offender residency restrictions would be against the sex offender, not a landlord. It was stated that the public should be made aware of the proposed ordinance. Motion (D'Alessandro/Rehberg) to recommend to Council that the sex offender residency restrictions with a child safety zone of 2,000 feet be considered. Payson; no. Motion carried.

**FEES FOR RETURNED CHECKS**

Finance Director Hinske stated that the Public Service Commission allows the City to charge customers a maximum of \$35.00 for returned checks. It was proposed that the City charge \$35.00 per check returned to the City for non-payment regardless of the purpose for which the check was written. Motion (Payson/Rehberg) to recommend to Council that Ordinance 3.019(2)(A) be modified. Motion carried.
