DISCUSSION: FIRE BOWLS

Administrator Tapson stated that he had recently received a complaint from a resident regarding the lack of regulations governing the use of commercial manufactured fire bowls and similar devices. The current ordinance does not address these but regulations could be added to Chapter 5. After discussion, motion (Payson/D'Alessandro) to recommend creation an exemption for commercially manufactured fire bowls in Chapter 5 of the City ordinances. Motion carried.
