ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 3, REGARDING CONTINGENCY FUND

Administrator Tapson said City Attorney Phillips reviewed the ordinance changes regarding the Contingency Account. **Motion (Huss/Rehberg) to recommend approval of the ordinance changes regarding the City's Contingency Account, Section 3.02.45. Motion carried.**

ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 8, REGARDING CAMPAIGN SIGNS

Administrator Tapson said the conflicting language regarding campaign signs in the right-of-way in Public Works and Zoning of the City's ordinance is addressed in this ordinance amendment. **Motion (Huss/Rehberg) to recommend approval of the ordinance changes in Chapter 8 regarding campaign signs. Motion carried.**

ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 19, REGARDING ELKHORN LAKE POWER BOAT PERMITTING

Administrator Tapson said language has been added to Chapter 19 to allow power boating on Elkhorn Lake. Fees were listed as well as special provisions for the use of the lake. Alderman Rehberg was concerned with the operation times for Saturday mornings, he asked it be changed from 8 a.m. to 10 a.m. **Motion (Huss/Rehberg) to recommend approval of the ordinance changes in Chapter 19 regarding Elkhorn Lake Power Boat Permitting, changing the Saturday hours to a start time of 10 a.m. Motion carried.**

The Police Department hadn't completed their background checks or premises inspections and the approval of the licenses was postponed until next month.
