REDUCTION IN POSTED SPEED LIMIT

Motion (Reynolds/Van Dyke) to recommend to Council a reduction in the speed limit on N. Wisconsin Street from Second Avenue to Lincoln Street from 30 mph to 25 mph. Motion carried by the majority present. The reduction would be consistent with the recent reduction on N. Lincoln Street.

SIDEWALK INSTALLATION REPORT

Public Works Director Weter presented a summary of sidewalks throughout the City and where there are none. Committee discussed whether the City should budget every year for filling in the areas that don't have sidewalks. Weter was asked to compare the sidewalk summary with the planned street projects to determine what sidewalks will be included in the projects. He was asked to prioritize those sidewalks needed that lead to parks and schools.

LIONS DEN CHANGE ORDER

Motion (Reynolds/Payson) to recommend to Council approval of a \$400 upgrade for the countertop in the Lions Den at Sunset Park and \$975 for pre-finished siding. Motion carried by the majority present.
