WATER SYSTEM CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Doug Snyder, Baxter & Woodman, updated Committee on the progress of the water utility projects. Well No. 8 is expected to be constructed by December 31, 2006. The Lakeland Facility expansion is expected to bid in late November. The well water transmission mains will connect Well No. 8 with the Lakeland Facility. Approximately 12,000 feet of water main are included. The Lakeland and Centralia Chlorination improvements are under review by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources and ready for bid in November. Snyder provided plans for the chlorination improvements.

S. CHURCH STREET RECONSTRUCTION/PARKING & SIDEWALKS

Members of St. Patrick's Parish and Tim Bartz, Bartz Chiropractic asked Committee for clarification concerning parking in the first block of S. Church Street. Those in attendance were under the impression that a boulevard was going in and that there would be no parking. It was explained by the Public Works Director and City Engineer that there may be parallel parking in that section. However, City Engineer Welsh said that it is a Police and Council decision as to whether there will be parallel parking in that area. There will be no angle parking. Welsh said there is no boulevard. Public Works Director Weter said at the onset of the project parallel parking was allowed. If parking is discussed at a Public Safety Committee meeting, St. Patrick's Parish asked that they be notified.
