WILLOW RUN WATER SUPPLY

Motion (Payson/Dunwiddie) to send the request by the Willow Run Condominium Association to supply water to the park without recommendation. Motion carried by the majority present.

Public Works Director Weter said the City can supply water, according to the DNR, to the park either as retail, which requires the association to bring its system up to City standards, or wholesale where everything beyond the metering point must be taken care of by the association. His recommendation in an operational view point it to go with wholesale with the condition that all costs associated with the project be the responsibility of the association and any out-of-pocket costs to the City would be recoverable. It would, however, set a precedent. Weter said that the only agreement to sell outside of the City limits has been to the Walworth County complex.
