**GREEN ACRES/OAKWOOD SUBDIVISION STORM WATER DRAINAGE**

Residents of Green Acres/Oakwood Subdivision were notified of the Committee and presented with a proposal for reconstructing the drainage areas along Maclean and Hickory Lanes in Green Acres/Oakwood Subdivision. Gary Payson Jr. was the spokesperson for the group. He questioned the map of the work planned for the improvements to the storm water drainage. He asked why 1105 and 1117 on Hickory Lane were not included in the plans. City Administrator Tapson said they were included after the drawing was sent out.

Tapson asked how the group felt about cost sharing. The City proposal was that the properties having to reconstruct their culverts would pay for saw cutting and installation. The City would pay for the culvert. The cost would be approximately \$2,000. Payson said they can't make a decision because the map is wrong. Mayor Giese asked if the corrections were made to the project would they be in favor of the cost sharing. Payson did not commit to the cost sharing.

In conclusion, City staff will meet with the City Engineer concerning the map. Payson was asked to send his questions to the City Administrator and he will forward them on to the City Engineer to research them and bring back the results to the January 14, 2008, Committee meeting at 6:30 p.m.
