ADVERTISING ON BASEBALL FIELDS AT HARRIS PARK

The Elkhorn Baseball Association had approached the Parks & Recreation Department asking for authorization to sell sponsorships/advertising at Harris Park. The advertising would be done on 4x6 vinyl banners and placed on the outfield fences. A portion of the monies would be used for upgrades to the fields. It was discussed that the banners would need to be tasteful and appropriate. Chairman Reynolds spoke in favor of a one year trial and informed the Association that they would not have exclusive rights. It was also discussed that the advertising should be for local businesses rather than distributors. Park & Recreation Director Simons stated that he would contact the school to determine whether there would be concerns about this advertising. Motion (Reynolds/Dunwiddie) to allow the Elkhorn Baseball Association to sell advertising for Harris Park on a one year trial basis. Motion carried.
