Chairman Ron Dunwiddie called the Municipal Services and Utilities Committee meeting at 4:00 p.m. followed by Roll Call.

ROLL CALL

SOLID WASTE/RECYCLING CONTRACT RENEWAL

After discussion, Alderman Norton stated that he was in favor of the City utilizing 65 gallon containers for the solid waste/recycling service. Aldermen DeHaan and Dunwiddie stated that there were in favor of the 95 gallon container. A recommendation will be made to Council to transition to the fully mechanized cart system for solid waste/recycling to begin on approximately April 1, 2011 utilizing 95 gallon containers.

STREET LIGHTS: 500 BLOCK OF DEVENDORF

Electric Director Schmitz stated that the resident at 503 Devendorf had requested additional street lights be installed in the 500 block. It was recommended that two lights be installed as the block is longer than is typical and there is a school driveway approach in the area. Motion (DeHaan/Norton) to recommend approval of the installation of two additional street lights at a cost of approximately \$5,000 and to make the necessary budget adjustment. Motion carried.

ADDITIONAL ASPHALT ON 3RD AVENUE

DPW Director Weter stated that it was discovered during the installation of the storm sewer on 3rd Avenue that the thickness of asphalt was inconsistent. The repairs are estimated at \$30,000 and could be added to the contract with Reeseman's as a change order. Motion (Norton/DeHaan) to recommend to Council that a change order for Reeseman's be approved to make the necessary repairs to 3rd Avenue. Motion carried.
