Chairman Ron Dunwiddie called the Municipal Services and Utilities Committee meeting at 4:00 p.m. followed by Roll Call.

E GENEVA @ CTH "H" LANE CROSSOVER

City Engineer Welsh reviewed suggested changes to the area including the elimination of the "gore" lane drop in favor of a full lane drop, removal of the W4-2, W9-1 and W9-2 signs which were previously installed. In addition, a second "Right Lane Must Turn Right" sign is recommended approximately 300 ft. in advance of the first sign when the speed limit is 40mph or under. Pavement marking changes recommended were extending the 8" dotted line to the location of the "Right Lane Must Turn Right" sign and extending the 4" broken line to the same sign. Motion (DeHaan/Norton) to approve the modifications suggested be made to these traffic lanes. Motion carried.
