**OAKWOOD LANE DRAINAGE DITCH**

It was stated that staff does not feel there is a drainage issue on Oakwood Lane. After discussion, the Committee asked that a letter be sent to the property owners seeking input regarding repairs to the ditch which are under consideration. Motion (Dunwiddie/Messerschmidt) to send letter to property owners as discussed. Motion carried.

**N WASHINGTON RECONSTRUCTION/RECONFIGURATION**

The option of creating a cul-du-sac on N Washington at Second Avenue was discussed. Administrator Tapson stated that this configuration is also an element of the redevelopment of Tasch Park which is contained in the recently completed Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation Plan. This would add approximately 150' of green space which would enable the park to expand in the future. In addition, this configuration would eliminate traffic speeding through the residential area. It was agreed that a neighborhood meeting regarding this reconstruction/reconfiguration would be held within the next 30 days. This matter is to be forwarded to the City Council for consideration.
