REQUEST FOR CITY TO ABANDON RIGHT-OF-WAY

Resident Duane Kurth has requested that the City release its current right-of-way to the abandoned rail siding that runs through his property at 203 S. Jackson. Administrator Tapson stated that this issue would have to go to the Plan Commission for consideration. It was discussed that either the property owner or potential buyer could be asked to pay any attorney, transfer or recording fees. Motion (Anderson/Payson) to recommend referral of this request to the Plan Commission with costs to be paid by property owner or buyer subject to the City retaining the storm sewer right-of-way on the property and subject to confirmation that the City doesn't own the street on the property. Motion carried.

CROSSWALK AT WESTSIDE SCHOOL

A concern had been raised by a resident at a recent Council meeting about an area of sidewalk near Westside School. He had stated that water pools in the area forcing children to cross the street in an alternate location. After discussion, it was agreed that the area be patched with a material that is guaranteed not to crack with freeze thaw cycles at a minimal cost, approximately \$500.
