The Municipal Services and Utilities Committee was called to order at 4:00 p.m. by Alderman Payson followed by roll call.

STOUGHTON MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT

Operations Manager Leach presented a mutual aid agreement with Stoughton Utilities for consideration. Motion (Anderson/Olson) to recommend approval of the mutual aid agreement to Council with review by the City Attorney as needed. Motion carried.

PARK & RECREATION ADA REQUIREMENTS

Park & Rec Director Simons provided information regarding the Federal ADA Title II law. It was stated that these laws include specific requirements for the removal of barriers at swimming pools. In addition, Title II deals with barriers within public areas which would include buildings, facilities, programs and parks. It was stated that CVMIC has identified the City as a beta site and will be making recommendations regarding compliance. It was stated that the deadline for installation of lifts at public swimming pools is May 21 however the Department of Justice is considering extending the deadline to September 17, 2012. An updated will be provided at a future meeting.

SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENT/MAINTENANCE PROGRAM

A draft for a sidewalk maintenance program was discussed which included broad guidelines for installation and continuing maintenance of public sidewalks. After discussion, it was agreed that the document will be revised and discussed further at a future meeting.
