CROSSWALK ENHANCEMENT

Chief Christensen presented information regarding erecting warning signs for pedestrians attempting to cross W. Walworth St. in the area of Sunset Park based on concerns received. It was stated that the pedestrian signs could be affixed to existing poles. Alderman Taylor suggested that if other signs are already in place on the same poles, perhaps some of the other signs should be relocated to avoid overload for drivers. Motion (McClory/Norton) to recommend to Council the installation of pedestrian warning signs in the area of Sunset Park not to exceed \$800. Motion carried.

BICYCLE PATROL POLICY

Chief Christensen presented a Bicycle Patrol policy for consideration which was drafted to meet CVMIC best practices and Wisconsin Law Enforcement Accreditation Group (WILEAG) standards. Motion (McClory/Taylor) to recommend to Council the adoption of the Bicycle Patrol Policy. Motion carried.
